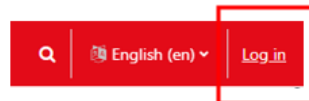


ADDING A WIKI ACTIVITY IN LEARN 2024

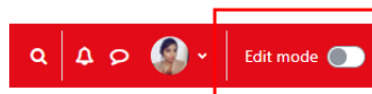
1. Go to <https://learn2024.ukzn.ac.za/>. Click on login at the top right of the homepage.



2. Enter your UKZN LAN credentials and click log in.

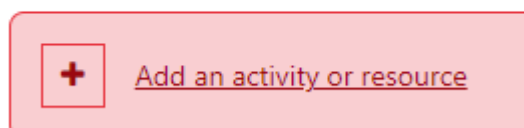


3. At the top right of your course page, switch edit mode on. Editing icons and links will appear. You can now edit your page accordingly.



4. Locate the Section where you want to add the WIKI activity add the Topic Name, and press enter.

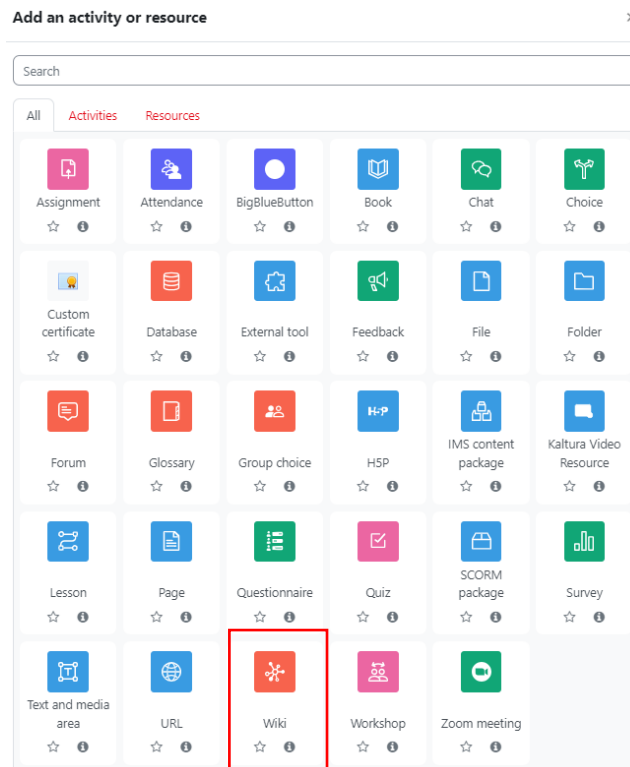

- At the bottom left of the Section, click + Add an activity or resource.

The Add an activity or resource window will open.

In the Add an activity or resource window, select. The Adding a new Wiki page will open.



6. Enter an informative name in the Wiki Name field on the Adding a new Wiki page. The name of the Wiki is mandatory.
7. In the Description box, enter a description that informs your students about the Wiki and your expectations for their participation.

Note: It is generally advisable to leave the Display description on the course page unchecked to avoid clutter on the main course page.
